# Spokane County USBC Trio Tournament Rules

1. This tournament will have two divisions. Teams with averages of 570 and over will be in the "A" division and teams with averages of 569 and under will be in the "B" division. Trio teams may be all men, all women or any mix of men and women. All teams will be combined in a single prize list in each division. Handicaps for both divisions will be 90% from 690 scratch.
2. **There will be at least one prize for each six entries.** Prize fees will be returned 100% in each division. Trophies will be awarded to the Handicap Champions in each division. All monetary prizes will be awarded on a handicap basis.
3. An Optional scratch prize list will be offered in this tournament. Bowlers must enter the handicap event to be eligible to enter the optional scratch event. **The optional entry fee for each event will be \$15 per person with all fees going to the prize fund.** No entry fee will be returned after acceptance of assigned schedule time. **There will be at least one prize for each six entries.** Prize fees will be returned 100% in this event. Trophies will be awarded to the Scratch Champions.
4. **Bowlers may bowl unlimited times in the team event. They can only cash once with the same team and must change one bowler to cash with another team.**
5. No more than one professional bowler will be allowed to bowl on a team. A professional bowler is defined as a bowler who holds a current membership card in the Professional Bowlers Association.
6. Entrants will use their highest certified winter league average, based on a minimum of 21 games, for the 2013-14 season. (Rule 319a1a) A 2014 certified summer league average, based on a minimum of 21 games, will be accepted if no 2013-14 certified winter league average is available. **Bowlers without a 2013-14 certified average will use their highest November 1, 2014 certified average for 21 games or more.** All others bowl scratch.
7. Entrants will have their entering average adjusted upward by 2/3 of the difference between their entering average and their SCUSBC tournament average if their SCUSBC tournament average for at least 12 games is 10 pins or more above their tournament entering average. Their SCUSBC tournament average is their average for all SCUSBC sanctioned tournament games bowled since August 1, 2009.
8. **Any bowler who has only a 2013-14 certified average from a non-standard league will have their average rerated based on the USBC Sport league adjustment chart.**
9. The Tournament Manager or an authorized representative may adjust an entrant's average upward prior to bowling. The entrant will be notified of any rerating and, if the entrant chooses not to bowl with the adjusted average, their entry fee will be refunded. Such adjustment may be appealed to the USBC within 15 days of the date of bowling or prior to the payment of prizes, whichever comes first. (Rule 319c)
10. It shall be each bowler's responsibility to verify the accuracy of their average in handicap or classified tournaments, whether originally submitted by the bowler, their team captain, or others. Failure to use the proper average or make a correction by the completion of the first game of a series shall disqualify score if submitted average is lower than actual or base prize winnings on submitted average if it is higher per USBC Rule 319a3.
11. USBC Rule 319d does not apply. (Reporting of prize winnings) USBC Rule 319e does not apply. (Average Adjustment rule). **All other USBC rules shall apply.**
12. Any player or team arriving late shall begin play with the score to count from the frame then being bowled. A bowler who misses one frame or more by not being present and ready to bowl in turn shall not be credited with any pins for the frames missed. (Rule 322a).
13. **Handicap Entry Fee: \$60 for entries received and paid (or postmarked) by November 1, 2014 or \$75 for entries received or paid after that date. (\$9.50 for Bowling fees, \$1.50 for expenses and the balance to be added to the prize fees.) All reservations for spots on the schedule made by phone or e-mail must be paid by November 1, 2014 to qualify for the \$60 entry fee.** No entry fee will be returned after acceptance of assigned schedule time.
14. Closing date of entries is 30 minutes before the start of the last scheduled squad. Walk in reservations will be accepted up to the start of last squad subject to lane availability.
15. All claims of error must be submitted in writing to the Tournament Manager within 72 hours after the bowler or team has bowled (Rule 329).
16. All participants must be **adult** members of the United States Bowling Congress (USBC). **Members from another association must pay local membership dues and provide verified averages from their association.** Non USBC members may establish eligibility by purchase of a USBC membership.
17. Changes in line-ups, or substitutions, must be made at the tournament office as early as possible, but in any event not later than 30 minutes prior to the start of the squad.
18. A tournament game, or frame(s) within a game, irretrievably lost in the scoring process may be rebowled with the approval of the Tournament Manager (see USBC Rule #327c).
19. **\$25 will be charged for any checks returned by the banks, credit unions, etc.**
