Spokane County USBC (SCUSBC) Championship Tournament Rules

Tournament Events

1. The Tournament shall consist of a four-woman team event, a doubles event and a singles event. Three consecutive games shall be bowled in each event and total pins with handicap shall decide the winners. This tournament will have one division in each event. **Handicap will be 90% from 210 scratch in singles, 420 scratch in doubles and 840 scratch in the team event.**
2. There will be at least one prize for each six entries. Trophies will be awarded to the Handicap Champions in each division. In case of a first place tie in ANY event, CO-CHAMPIONS will be declared and trophies given to all champions.
3. Optional scratch and handicap All Events will be offered. Bowlers may enter the handicap and/or scratch All Events by paying the optional entry fee(s). The total of nine games bowled in team, doubles and singles shall determine the all events winners. There will be at least one prize for each ten entries.
4. A Grand Duchess award will be presented to the participant age 70 or over who bowls the highest scratch all events score in the tournament. **Entrants will be automatically entered in the Grand Duchess event if eligible. (Payment of All Events entry fees are not required to receive this award.)**

Tournament Fees

5. **Handicap Entry Fees:** \$100 for Team, \$50 for Doubles and \$25 for Singles. (\$10.00 for Bowling, \$2.00 for Expenses and the balance to be added to the prize fund. **Early entries (received and paid (or postmarked) by September 26, 2015) will receive a \$5 discount for their team, doubles and singles events.** No entry fees will be returned after acceptance of assigned schedule times.
6. The handicap All Events entry fee is \$5 and the scratch All Events entry fee is \$5 with all fees going to the prize fund. There will be at least one prize for each ten entries. Prize fees will be returned 100% within each All Events prize fund.

Tournament Participation

7. **Bowlers may bowl unlimited times in the Team event, the Doubles event and the Singles event. They can only cash once with the same Team or Doubles and must change two bowlers in Team and one bowler in Doubles to cash again in that event.** The first Team event, the first Singles event and the first Doubles event counts in All Events. An individual can only cash once in the Singles event per USBC Rule 315c.
8. All participants must be **adult** female members of the United States Bowling Congress (USBC). **Members from another association must pay local membership dues and provide verified averages from their association.** Non-USBC members may establish eligibility by purchase of a USBC membership.
9. If her partner has not arrived by the time the doubles event starts, and a substitute is not available, she will be permitted to bowl her games in the doubles event in order to qualify for all events.
10. In case of emergency after a game has started, a substitute, if one is available, shall be allowed in the team and doubles events only. The combined scores are to count in either of these events. If no substitute is available, only the actual score of the frames bowled shall count. A substitute shall take the place of the original entrant in the lineup.

Tournament Averages

11. **Average:** Entrants will use their highest certified league average based on a minimum of 21 games for the 2014-15 season. **(Rule 319a1a)** If no average last year, use highest certified league average, 21 games or more, as of October 3, 2015 per USBC Rule 319a 1-2. A 2015 summer league average will be accepted only if no 2014-15 yearbook average or October 3, 2015 average is available. All others bowl scratch.
12. **Any bowler who has only a 2014-15 certified average from a non-standard league will have their average rerated based on the USBC Sport league adjustment chart.**
13. **The Tournament Manager or an authorized representative may adjust an entrant's average upward prior to bowling.** The entrant will be notified of any rerating and if the entrant chooses not to bowl with the adjusted average their entry fee will be refunded. Such adjustment may be appealed to the USBC within 15 days of the date of bowling or prior to the payment of prizes, whichever comes first. (Rule 319c)

Tournament Rules

14. It shall be each bowler's responsibility to verify the accuracy of their average in handicap or classified tournaments, whether originally submitted by the bowler, their team captain, or others. Failure to use the proper average or make a correction by the completion of the first game of a series shall disqualify score if submitted average is lower than actual or base prize winnings on submitted average if it is higher per USBC Rule 319a3.
15. USBC Rule 319d does not apply. (Reporting of prize winnings) USBC Rule 319e(1&2) does not apply. (Average Adjustment rule) **All other USBC rules shall apply.**
16. A tournament game or frame(s) within a game irretrievably lost in the scoring process may be rebowled with the approval of the Tournament Official. (See USBC rule 327c).
17. Any player or team arriving late shall begin play with the score to count from the frame then being bowled. A bowler who misses one frame or more by not being present and ready to bowl in turn shall not be credited with any pins for the frames missed. (Rule 322a)
18. All claims of error must be submitted in writing to the Tournament Manager within 72 hours after the bowler or team has bowled. (Rule 329)
19. Closing date of entries is 30 minutes before the start of the last scheduled squad. All entry fees must accompany the entry blank. Walk in reservations will be accepted up to the start of the last squad subject to lane availability.
20. Changes in line-ups, or substitutions, must be made at the tournament office as early as possible, but in any event not later than 30 minutes prior to the start of the squad.
21. **Dress attire must be neat, clean and proper fitting.** No torn jeans, no sweat or pajama pants, no bare midriffs, no hats and no shorts except for walking shorts (knee length) may be worn.
22. \$25 will be charged for any checks returned by the banks, credit unions, etc.

Doubles and Singles are now separate events. Doubles and Singles will be scheduled separately and will be bowled in separate squads. Bowlers may enter Doubles and Singles separately and are not required to enter both events.
