Spokane County USBC Mixed Team Championship Tournament Rules

Tournament Events

1. The Tournament shall consist of a four-person mixed team event. **Teams must consist of 2 male and 2 female bowlers.** Three consecutive games shall be bowled and total pins with handicap shall decide the winners. This tournament will have one division with handicap calculated as 90% of the difference between 230 and the bowler's average.
2. **There will be at least one prize for each six entries.** Trophies will be awarded to the Handicap Champions. In case of a first place tie, CO-CHAMPIONS will be declared and trophies given to all champions.

Tournament Fees

3. Handicap Entry Fees: \$120 for Team (\$12.00 for bowling, \$2.00 for expenses and the balance to be added to the prize fund. **Early entries (received and paid (or postmarked) by February 6, 2016) will receive a \$5.00 per person discount from their handicap entry fees.** No entry fees will be returned after acceptance of assigned schedule times.

Tournament Participation

4. Bowlers may bowl unlimited times in the Team event. They can only cash once with the same Team and must change two bowlers in the Team event to cash again.
5. All participants must be **adult** members of the United States Bowling Congress (USBC). **Members from another association must pay local membership dues and provide verified averages from their association.** Non-USBC members residing within the jurisdiction of the Spokane County USBC may establish eligibility by purchase of a USBC membership.
6. **Substitutes:** In case of emergency after a game has started, a substitute, if one is available, shall be allowed. If no substitute is available, only the actual score of the frames bowled shall count. A substitute shall take the place of the original entrant in the lineup.

Tournament Averages

7. Entrants will use their highest certified league average based on a minimum of 21 games for the 2014-15 season. **(Rule 319a 1a)** If no average last year, use highest certified league average, 21 games or more, as of January 1, 2016 per USBC Rule 319a 1-2. A 2015 summer league average will be accepted only if no 2014-15 yearbook average or January 1, 2016 average is available. All others bowl scratch.
8. **Any bowler who has only a 2014-15 certified average from a non-standard league will have their average rerated based on the USBC Sport league adjustment chart.**

9. **The Tournament Manager or an authorized representative may adjust an entrant's average upward prior to bowling.** The entrant will be notified of any rerating and if the entrant chooses not to bowl with the adjusted average their entry fee will be refunded. Such adjustment may be appealed to the USBC within 15 days of the date of bowling or prior to the payment of prizes, whichever comes first. (Rule 319c).

Tournament Rules

10. It shall be each bowler's responsibility to verify the accuracy of their average in handicap or classified tournaments, whether submitted by the bowler, their team captain, or others. Failure to use the proper average or make a correction by the completion of the first game of a series shall disqualify score if submitted average is lower than actual or base prize winnings on submitted average if it is higher per USBC Rule 319a3.
11. USBC Rule 319d does not apply. (Reporting of prize winnings) USBC Rule 319e(1&2) does not apply. (Average Adjustment rule) **All other USBC rules shall apply.**
12. A tournament game or frame(s) within a game irretrievably lost in the scoring process may be rebowled with the approval of the Tournament Official. (See USBC rule 327c).
13. Any player or team arriving late shall begin play with the score to count from the frame then being bowled. A bowler who misses one frame or more by not being present and ready to bowl in turn shall not be credited with any pins for the frames missed. (Rule322a).
14. All claims of error must be submitted in writing to the Tournament Manager within 72 hours after the bowler or team has bowled. (Rule 329)
15. Closing date of entries is 30 minutes before the start of the last scheduled squad. All entry fees must accompany the entry blank. Walk in reservations will be accepted up to the start of the last squad subject to lane availability.
16. Changes in line-ups, or substitutions, must be made at the tournament office as early as possible, but in any event not later than 30 minutes prior to the start of the squad.
17. **Dress attire must be neat, clean and proper fitting.** No torn jeans, no sweat or pajama pants, no bare midriiffs, no hats and no shorts except for walking shorts (knee length) may be worn.
18. \$25 will be charged for any checks returned by the banks, credit unions, etc.
19. If the tournament, or squads in the tournament, is cancelled due to unforeseen circumstances, the entry fees for bowlers scheduled in the cancelled squad(s) will be refunded.

Teams must consist of 2 male and 2 female bowlers. Trophies will be awarded to the tournament winners.
